Subj:- Re-fixation of seniority of Mr. Mohammad Ishaq Beigh, Storekeeper R.No. 4463
Ref:- Order No. 655 DFCS&CAK of 2023 dated 28.02.2023

(Notification)

Whereas, one Mr. Mohammad Ishaq Beigh Storekeeper R.No. 4463 represented before this office stating therein that he was due for promotion as Assistant Storekeeper in the year 2007, however he was not considered owing to the fact that he was placed under suspension during the year 2003, reinstated in the year 2005 and the intervening period of suspension was treated as leave whatever kind due and was later on promoted in the year 2011 due to which his juniors found way ahead of him and also requested for maintenance of his seniority;

Whereas, as per the available records, Mr. Mohammad Ishaq Beigh was placed under suspension by Assistant Director Anantnag vide No. CA&PD/AD-Antg/2671-72 dated 12.09.2003 in connection with misappropriation of Govt. food grains to the tune of Rs. 1,98,191.61 and later on reinstated vide order No.106 DCA&PDK of 2005 dated 12.12.2005 and balance amount of Rs. 68,653.69 was ordered to be recovered @ 40% from his monthly salary. The intervening period of suspension was undecided. The case of the official for promotion as Assistant Storekeeper was placed in DPC held on 08.10.2007 and following decision was taken in respect of the said official;

"He was under suspension in connection with misappropriation of Govt. foodgrains. He has been reinstated on 12.12.2005. Balance amount of Rs. 68653.69 ordered to be recovered from his monthly salary & 40%. CAO has reported Rs. 23550.00 outstanding. Period of suspension w.e.f 12.09.2003 to 11.12.2005 undecided"

Whereas, the Chief Accounts Officer vide letter No. DCAPD/Accts/TA Qzd/177-178 dated 14.02.2008 reported that nothing is outstanding against the Mohammad Ishaq Beigh on this account;

Whereas, the case for promotion was again placed in the DPC held on 24.01.2009 and following decision was taken:-

"He was placed under suspension for shortages in foodgrains and subsequently reinstated. Suspension period from 12.09.2003 to 11.12.2005 is undecided. One post has been kept reserve against the official till next DPC meeting"

Whereas, vide office order No. DCAPDK/Adm/SH-44 dated 06.01.2010 read with letter No. DCAPDK/Adm/SH-44 dated 19.05.2011, the intervening period of suspension w.e.f 12.09.2003 to 11.12.2005 was treated as on leave whatever kind was due to him;

Whereas, in the DPC held on 20.11.2010, he was cleared for the promotion as Jr. SK in the pay scale of Rs. 4440-7440+ grade pay 1400 and in the DPC held on 28.12.2011, he was accordingly promoted as Assistant Storekeeper w.e.f. 28.12.2011.

Whereas, the case was placed before the Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) Meeting held on 26.09.2022 with full facts and following decision was taken in the instant case:-

"Cleared notionally from the dates his junior counterparts have been cleared as Assistant Storekeeper and Storekeeper and monetarily w.e.f. 26.09.2022 (date of conduct of DPC) subject to receipt of vigilance clearance, work and conduct/integrity and APRS"


Whereas, the Deputy / Under Secretary, General Administration Department forwarded satisfactory vigilance clearance in favour of Mr. Mohammad Ishaq Belgh through online mode vide Form No. 176209 dated 23.01.2023;

Whereas, in view of above and as recommended by Departmental Promotion Committee in its meeting held on 26.09.2022, the promotion granted to Mr. Mohammad Ishaq Belgh as Assistant Storekeeper in the pay level of Rs. 19900-63200 (L. 2) w.e.f. 28.12.2011 was ordered to take effect from 08.10.2007 notionally and as Storekeeper in the pay level of Rs. 25500-81100 (L4) w.e.f. 01.04.2018 notionally (i.e. the date his junior counterparts have been promoted) and monetarily w.e.f. 26.09.2022 vide order referred to above;

Whereas, Mr. Mohammad Ishaq Belgh was appearing at seniority No. 1653 in the seniority list of Class-IV category finalized vide order No. 201 DFSK of 2002 dated 15.02.2002. His immediate matriculate junior counterpart namely Mr. Parvaiz Ahmad R.No. 4465 was appearing at seniority No. 1655 in the said finalized seniority list of Class-IV officials. Besides, Mr. Parvaiz Ahmad is appearing at seniority No. 52 in the seniority list of Storekeepers finalized vide order No. 452 DFCS&CAK of 2020 dated 21.09.2020 and both the above officials have also been placed as I/c TSO with charge allowance vide order No. 684 DFCS&CAK of 2023 dated 05.04.2023;

Now, therefore, before seniority of Mr. Mohammad Ishaq Belgh is re-fixed at seniority No. 50/A below Mr. Sarvar Hussain R.No. 4782, Seniority No. 50 and above Mr. Parvaiz Ahmad Sheikh R.No. 4465, Seniority No. 52 (as the official namely Mohd Ismail Dar, R.No. 4462 Seniority No. 51 has already retired from services) in the finalized seniority list of Storekeepers, this notification is accordingly issued for inviting objections, if any, from the concerned officials within a period of seven days and thereafter no objection shall be entertained.
