

The above said allocation is subject to the following conditions that:-

1. The Director FCS&CA, Kashmir/Jammu shall recoup their revolving fund (Food Grain) Account @Rs. 18.50 per Kg from Govt. of India as subsidy and Rs. 13.50 per Kg shall be recouped on account of sale proceed. The deficit amount shall be recouped by projecting budgetary provisions in the revised budget estimates for the

2. The Director FCS&CA, Kashmir /Jammu shall lift the Sugar quota in respect of AAY beneficiaries only. Any excess lifting that subsequently gets dumped in the godowns will be responsibility of the Director.

3. The detailed account of the expenditure /Utilization Certificate as per the prescribed format be submitted to the Administrative Department on monthly basis.

4. The Director FCS&CA, Kashmir /Jammu shall ensure that all the transactions should be through PoS machines only.
