Subject:- Allocation of Foodgrains (Rice and Wheat) under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojna (PMGKAY) for distribution among beneficiaries (AAY & PHH including covered under DBT) @5Kg per person per month (Free of Cost) for the month of September 2021.

Consequent upon the allotment conveyed by the Administrative Department vide above referred communication, **Sanction is hereby accorded to the:-**

1. Lifting/Procurement of **186153.35 Qtls of Foodgrains viz; 176845.68 Qtls of Rice and 9307.67 Qtls of Wheat** from FCI by Assistant Director Stores under **Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojna (PMGKAY)** for the month of **September 2021** as per the category wise breakup given below:

2. Release of Foodgrains to the extent of **186072.20 Qtls viz; 176768.58 Qtls of Rice and 9303.62 Qtls of Wheat** in favour of Assistant Directors of Kashmir Division by Assistant Director Stores FCS&CAK as per the District wise/ category wise break up given in **Annexure "A"** to this order.


The concerned Assistant Directors shall lift the entire released quantity by 31st of August 2021 and ensure its dispatch to the respective sale outlets for its **monthly** distribution amongst bonafide rationees **(Free of Cost)** through **PoS devices only** for the month of **September 2021**.

The above allocation is however, subject to the fulfillment of following terms and conditions that:-

1. The allocated quantity is lifted from the specified loading point within the stipulated time frame.
2. The allocated quantity should be distributed **free of cost** to AAY and PHH beneficiaries only as per the prescribe scale conveyed by Administrative Department through **POS devices only**.

3. The Assistant Directors shall give wide publicity about the additional allocation (FOC) under PMOKAY and encourage migrant beneficiaries to use the facility of portability under ONORC.
4. The monthly lifting / off-take statements should invariably be furnished to this Directorate regularly in time without any fail.
5. The Assistant Directors shall draw advance centre-wise roaster/requirement of different commodities as per the format in vogue and shall submit a copy of the same to this Directorate for prior approval, before issuance of ration among the consumers.
6. The Assistant Directors shall be personally responsible for proper distribution of ration amongst the bonafide consumers on monthly basis.
7. The Assistant Directors shall keep strict vigil against pilferage at any sale outlets.
8. The Assistant Directors shall furnish the information regarding daily lifting and dispatches of foodgrains to the Directorate from the following day without any fail.
9. The sale records shall be deposited in the respective piece checking section for inspection and records by 5th of the following month after conduct of sale of the foodgrains.
10. The un-lifted quantity, if any, owing to failure by any District, shall be correspondingly deducted from the next month's allocation and the un-lifted quantity shall not be re-allotted during the next month.
11. The entire quantity for a particular centre out of the above allocation due for the month, shall be dumped in one go, as per FIFO methodology.
12. The under-scaling of rations if any, shall be treated as misappropriation and embezzlement.
13. The TSO/storekeeper/FP Shop dealers shall ensure distribution of foodgrains to the identified beneficiaries under the Act.
14. The Storekeeper shall deposit the sale records signed by village Heads/Mohalla Heads duly countersigned by TSO concerned.
15. The TSO/ storekeeper shall maintain the acquaintance Rolls/ Register.
16. A separate physical/financial account should be maintained.
17. The ADs shall ensure implementation of the above terms and conditions in letter and spirit. Deviation, if any, shall attract disciplinary action against the erring officer.
