Subject: - Allocation of Fortified Rice for 2nd Quarter (July-September 2022) of F.Y 2022-23 under the scheme Wheat Based Nutrition Programme (WBNP) and National Food Security Act (NFSA) 2013 to meet the supplementary nutrition under the Anganwadi services umbrella ICDS.

Consequent upon the allotment of Fortified Rice conveyed by the Administrative Department vide above referred communication under the scheme Wheat Based Nutrition Programme (WBNP) and National Food Security Act (NFSA) 2013 for 2nd Quarter, 2022-2023 i.e. (July to September 2022), Assistant Director Stores FCS&CA Kashmir is hereby authorized to lift/procure Rice (Fortified) from FCI to the extent of 1483.600 MTs under Wheat Based Nutrition Programme (Anganwadi Services) for its further release in favour Assistant Directors of FCS&CA Kashmir Division as per the district wise breakup given in Annexure "A" to this order.

The concerned Assistant Directors shall lift the entire released quantity and ensure its dispatch to the respective sale outlets for its further lifting/distribution by the linked Anganwadi Centres (ICDS).

The above allocation is however, subject to the fulfillment of following terms and conditions that:-

1. The Assistant Directors of FCS&CA Kashmir are directed to keep liaison with the concerned district Programme Officers ICDS and seek the store wise requirement and frame the lifting strategy thereof.
2. The allocated quantity must be lifted from the specified loading point within the stipulated time frame.

3. The allocated quantity should be distributed to the identified Anganwadi Centers only and the monthly lifting / off-take statements and consolidated Utilization Certificates on quarterly basis be furnished to this directorate regularly in time without any fail.
4. No Diversion/ re-appropriation from one scheme to another or one category to another shall be allowed.
5. The Assistant Directors shall be personally responsible for proper distribution of ration amongst the Anganwadi Centers.
6. The Assistant Directors shall keep strict vigil against pilferage/ misappropriation reported at any sale outlets under their respective jurisdictions.
7. A separate physical/financial account should be maintained.
8. The ADs shall ensure implementation of the above terms and conditions in letter and spirit. Deviation, if any, shall attract disciplinary action against the erring officer.

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
