 Release of 2963.96 Qtls of Rice and 955.99 Qtls of Wheat under NFSA in favour of Assistant Directors of FCS&CA Kashmir as per the breakup given in Annexure "A" to this order.

The concerned Assistant Directors shall lift the entire released quantity and ensure its dispatch to the respective dumping stations for its further distribution amongst bonafide rationees through PoS devices only.

Besides, the allotment made in respect of districts in advance shall be recouped on monthly basis from November 2022 onwards by or before June 2023 under respective categories/schemes.

The above allocation is however, subject to the fulfillment of following terms and conditions that:

- The allocated quantity is lifted from the specified loading point within the stipulated time frame.
- The allocated quantity should be distributed to the identified beneficiaries strictly in accordance with instructions of Administrative Department I.e. through PoS only.
- The monthly lifting / off-take statements as per prescribed format under NFSA should invariably be furnished to this directorate regularly in time without any fail.
- 4. No Diversion/ re-appropriation from one scheme to another one category to another is allowed and the ration should be issued only to the bonafide rationees after proper identification and on eash payment specified by the government for each category under NFSA.
- 5. The Assistant Director shall draw advance centre-wise roaster/requirement of different commodities us per the format in vogue and shall submit a copy of the same to this Directorate for prior approval, before Issuance of ration among the consumers.

- The Assistant Director shall be personally responsible for proper distribution of ration amongst the bonafide consumers as per the data generated under NFSA.
- The Assistant Director shall keep strict vigil against pilferage and overcharging reported at any sale outlets.
- The Assistant Director shall furnish the information regarding daily lifting and dispatches of foodgrains to the Directorate on the following day without any fall.
- The sale records shall be deposited in the respective piece checking section for inspection and records by 5th of the following month after conduct of sale of the fooderains.
- 10. The sale proceeds shall be deposited as per the norms/procedure in vogue after completion of the distribution of foodgrains by 5th of the following month positively.
- 11. The un-lifted quantity, if any, owing to failure by any District, shall be correspondingly deducted from the next month's allocation and the un-lifted quantity shall not be re-allotted during the next month.
- 12. The entire quantity for a particular centre out of the above allocation due for the month, shall be dumped in one go, as per FIFO methodology.
- The under-scaling of rations if any, shall be treated as misappropriation and embezzlement.
- 14. The TSO/storekeeper/FP Shop dealers shall ensure distribution of foodgrains to the identified beneficiaries under the Act.
- 15. The Storekeeper shall deposit the sale records signed by village Heads/Mohalla Heads duly countersigned by TSO concerned.
- 16. The TSO/ storekeeper shall maintain the acquaintance Rolls/ Register.
- 17. A separate physical/financial account should be maintained.
- 18. The AD shall ensure implementation of the above terms and conditions in letter and spirit. Deviation, if any, shall attract disciplinary action against the erring officer.
