Kindly refer to the subject and reference cited above. In this context undersigned is directed to convey the additional allocation of **176.986** MTs of foodgrains (**122.192** MTs of Rice and **54.794** MTs of Wheat) under **NFSA** for its distribution during the month of September 2023 and October 2023 amongst the genuine beneficiaries through intra-state portability across Kashmir division with the condition that all the distribution of foodgrains should be through PoS devices only, strictly, as per the entitlements and no manual distribution is allowed as directed earlier.

Besides, the Directorate shall ensure the proper reconciliation of additional allocations of foodgrains made earlier under NFSA/NPHH with the Administrative Department.

The lifting of foodgrain should be ensured urgently.
